We need this information to help in the process of building our teams.

Expectations for Coaches: general knowledge of soccer, work with co-coach to organize practices and games, initiate contact with parents, help setup and take down of goals, maintain equipment bag.

Expectations of Parent Volunteers: help with parent contact; help organize the final celebration of the team.

New Coaches need to complete a GBGSL Coach Eligibility Disclosure form and a Vermont Release Form and return them by April 1st, 2010 to GBGSL Administrator, PMB 127, 150 Dorset St., Ste 245, South Burlington, VT 05403 to be processed. Forms can be found at www.qbgsl.org

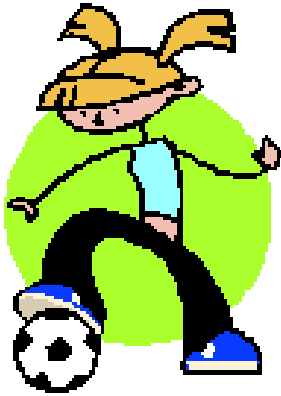
Veteran GBGSL Coaches - New This Season: If you have coached in GBGSL in the past and we have your information on file, we will re-submit your Vermont Release Form to the Vermont Criminal Information Center to update our records: you are not required to complete this form each season. However, please be sure we have your current phone number and email address on your daughters registration form.

Recreational Girls Soccer for GRADES K-6

Spring 2010 Season is May 8st – June 12th, 2010

Registration is now open!
Registration deadline is March 20th!

- **Girls must be in K-6 to play (for 2009-2010 school year)**
We invite participation from girls regardless of their level of skill.
**If the demand of the league exceeds the capabilities of the player, parents will be expected to work with the coach at the start of the season, and assist the coach/team during the season to support their child and the team. Alternatively, the parent may have the child participate with the assistance of an 'aide' or 1:1 support person provided by the parent.
- **All games are at Calahan Park in Burlington**
 - Games are on Saturdays between 8AM and 1PM; schedules will be emailed to coaches and posted on the website www.gbgsf.org, typically a week before the first game of the season.
- **Practices:** Practice times & locations are set by the coaches for each team.
- **Space is only guaranteed if registration is received on by deadline**
 - Registration fee is \$30 (kindergarten is \$25).
 - Scholarships are available. Please indicate on back of registration form
 - Late registration postmarked AFTER March 20th is \$50 and will only be accepted if space is still available!
- **Email address:** Please provide an email address on your registration form. Email notice will be sent to parents with coaches' name about 2 weeks before the season starts.
- **Equipment:** Team shirts are provided. Girls must wear shin guards to play. No earrings or jewelry can be worn during play - at games or practices
A **Cleat Swap** is planned for opening day – please bring old cleats to donate or to trade up for a new size. Bring a spare pair of sneakers in case you don't find a match. **Lost and Found:** found items are collected in the shed – if you've lost something you may find it there.
- **Coaches:** All GBGSL Coaches are volunteers – mostly parents like you. GBGSL is always in need of coaches. Look for coaching clinic dates and resources on our website. www.gbgsf.org
